COVID-19 Screening Process & Visitation Guidelines



The safety of our patients, staff and the community remain our priority. We appreciate your cooperation in following our COVID-19 visitation policy outlined below.

Visitation may be temporarily suspended in the event of:

- New facility onset patient case of COVID in the previous 14 days
- New facility onset staff case in the previous 14 days, in which the staff member was present in the facility for 10 days prior to positive test

Screening Process

You will be asked to provide your name and contact information.

NO VISITING IF:

Temperature will be taken.	Greater than 100 degrees
Have you had close contact with someone with a COVID-19 diagnosis in the last 14 days?	Yes
Have you had a positive COVID-19 diagnosis (last 10-days)?	Yes
Are you experiencing one or more of the following new symptoms: chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea, or new loss of taste or smell?	Yes
Are you experiencing two or more of the following new symptoms: muscle or body aches, headache, sore throat, congestion, runny nose?	Yes

Visitor Guidelines

Designated hours	Visitors <u>must be</u> 18+ years old	Visitors will be screened upon arrival
One visitor per patient, per day	Visitors restricted to patient room only	No hospital re-entry on the same day
Visitors may bring a mask, or one will be provided	Visitors <u>must</u> wear a mask at all times	Visitors <u>must</u> wash hands before entering and exiting room
Visitors <u>must</u> adhere to 6-foot social distancing	No eating or drinking permitted in patient room	Visitors NOT PERMITTED: - COVID-19 diagnosis in the last 10 days - Patients awaiting COVID-19 test results - COVID-19 recovery patients

In some cases, you may be screened by our partner hospital at the point of entry. When you arrive at our facility, we will validate their screen.
